

**Kenneth E. Hagin gave the following word on June 1, 1998 in Pennsauken, New Jersey:**

(Tongues with interpretation) "He is just the same today. He never changes and He manifests Himself today as He did of yore. So believe ye and ye shall see. Tune into the Spirit, listen to what He has to say and He'll guide you in the right path and lead you in the right direction.

"Impart unto your spirit; knowledge and revelation and give illumination unto your mind and so you shall rejoice and be exceedingly glad (ha, ha, ha) for the Lord is at work and He is the same today as He was yesterday.

"There have been different revivals through the years. A revival is a renewal. You can't revive something that hasn't been there before. At the turn of the century that was the outpouring of the Holy Ghost: speaking in tongues and baptism in the Holy Ghost and out of that came all the Pentecostal movements. Healing needed to be renewed so there was the Healing Revival from 1947-58.

"Then there was the Charismatic move. God visited denominational churches and hungry people everywhere and filled them with the Holy Ghost from 1950-1959. But people needed to be taught. They are not going to make it unless there are. So there came a revival of the teaching ministry.

"In more recent times, we had a revival of joy since people got dead and dry and they needed a revival of joy. Renewal. Renewal. And so folks rejoiced in that and they should. And thank God there are physical demonstrations. People responding to the Holy Ghost.

"Laughter is one of them. Psalms 126:1-3 says, 'Then the Lord turned again the captivity of Zion, we were like them that dream. Then was our mouth filled with laughter, and our tongue with singing: then said they among the heathen, The Lord hath done great things for them. The Lord hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad.'

"Well, thank God our captivity has been turned. Some people call it the laughing revival. Medical science has proved that laughing will lower your blood pressure. Proverbs 17:22 says, 'A merry

heart doeth good like a medicine.' God knew this ahead of time. God wants to help people. There's such a thing as laughing in the Spirit; dancing in the Spirit.

"On the day of Pentecost, they thought they were drunk. There's such a thing as getting drunk in the Spirit. Thank God for all of that but that's not the ultimate. If you just go there and stop and shout and jump, you're going to miss it. Come on into the full manifestation of the Spirit.

"In the manifestation of Gifts (of the Spirit) in the visitation of the Holy Ghost visions; the Holy Ghost directing. And the Holy Ghost said, "Separate unto Barnabas and Saul and they being sent forth by the Holy Ghost. It makes a difference."

(Tongues with interpretation) "We've come full circle. Now it is time to move on. Not keep moving in the same circle, but move on, move on into the fullness of the Spirit. Move on into the fullness of His power. Move on into the outpouring of His glory until His glory shall be seen upon those who are called and their face shall shine like the face of an angel and their tongues shall be set on fire of God and they shall speak and they shall minister and the Lord shall be magnified and He shall be lifted up and the glory of God shall be made known among His people.

"So rejoice and be glad and do not be satisfied to sit still. Do not be satisfied with where you are but move up and move on."

(Tongues and laughter) "Hunger, hunger after the things of God. Thirst, thirst after the things of God. Open, be open unto the things of God. Don't be satisfied with where you are. Don't be satisfied with what you got.

"Want more, desire more, sincerely seek more and He'll manifest Himself unto you. Put Christ above all things. Crucify the flesh; crucify the flesh. Walk in the Spirit and you'll not fulfill the desires of the flesh and the glory of God shall rest upon you and His power shall be made manifest unto you, and He shall be glorified.

(Tongues with interpretation) "Stir yourself up. Don't wait for God to stir you up. Stir yourself up. Stir yourself up to pray. Stir yourself up to seek God. Stir yourself up. Paul told Timothy to stir up the gift that is in thee. Stir up the Holy Ghost that's

within you and drink ye of the Spirit. And the power of God will fall upon you like water from heaven. Turning, turning, turning, turning. This is a turning point.

"Tonight is a turning point in your life, in my life, in our lives. But we've turned in the right direction. It will never be the same again. It will come to pass.

"It will come to pass. It will come to pass. It will come to pass. The Lord kept saying to me for the past two years or so in prayer, "It will come to pass. It will come to pass at last."
