

The following portion of prophecy was delivered through Kenneth E. Hagin on January 9, 1991:

If you learn to follow the Spirit in all that you do, in your preaching, in your singing, in your worship, then the Spirit will lead you into the deep things of God. And yea, He'll manifest Himself in your midst, and you'll see things that your hearts have longed to see. Men endeavor to cause those things to come to pass by their own machinations and their own activity, but it shall only come as you give right place to the Spirit of God and to the Word of God and worship Him in Spirit and in truth. That's what the Holy Ghost is saying.

It's obeying the Lord. It's walking in the pathway of obedience that brings the blessing of God. For obedience is better than sacrifice. Not what I planned, not what man planned, not what somebody else planned, not accepting someone else's formula for success. For though it may look from the natural standpoint that folks are having success, if the Lord does not build the house, they labor in vain that build it. So, get the mind of God for your own life. Get the mind of God for your own ministry. Yea, wait in His presence. Wait in His presence and lay on the altar all the desires of the flesh and ask yourself, "Why do I want to do this? Am I doing this, am I following this pattern or that pattern because He said so or just because I want to? Am I in the ministry because I want to be there? Am I a pastor of this church because I want to be there, or is it because He wants me to be there?"

Get all of those desires sanctified. Present them unto God, then you'll find that you have desires from God. And into your spirit and into your heart there'll come a strength, there'll come a power, there'll come a peace that has never been there before. And there will come an anointing upon your life and upon your ministry that you've not before experienced. And it'll almost seem as though you're turned into another person, like it said of Saul of old, "Thou shalt have much cause for rejoicing." So, look ye, believe ye and act ye, and so it shall surely be.

The following prophecy was given through Brother Kenneth E. Hagin at Living Word Christian Center in January 1991:

For I know the Lord has spoken to me, for I know the Lord has spoken unto me. For I know the Lord has spoken unto me, for I know the Lord has spoken unto me. Yea, I know that Lord has spoken unto me. But what He said unto me has not come to pass. Yea, I see no fruits. Yea, the vision that He gave me, nothing has happened. waiting, the Lord is going to do it. Yes, I know He is. But in the meantime, you be faithful. Faithful to proclaim the Word of God. Faithful to preach the Word. Not searching around and looking to see how and what I can do to cause it to come to pass or to make it to come to pass. Because you can do neither one of the two. You cannot cause it to come to pass and you cannot make it come to pass. But it shall only come to pass as a crown of your faithfulness. As a crown of your commitment. So, stay steady. Don't be moved by every wind of doctrine that comes on the horizon at times. Stay steady. Stay steady. Just preach the Word. Just teach the Word. Just trust the Word. I'm trusting the Word to do the work, for the Word will produce results. So I'm trusting that Word. For trusting the Word is trusting God and surely He shall bring it to pass. Oh yes, yes, yes, you may weep. Weep - oh Lord, I know you told me to do this. I'm confident that You sent me here. Oh Lord, but I see no results. The harvest is so slim, so few, oh what am I to do? Oh, what am I to do? Yea," saith the Lord, "Lay aside your tears. Lay aside your weeping. Quit feeling sorry for yourself. Just say, 'I'm obeying the Lord. I'll trust the results with Him. My faith is in Him and in His Word, and I'll keep my word with You.' And the anointing shall come upon you in a fresh way. Yea, thou shalt be anointed with fresh oil, and if you will, you will go from this place, and when you return to your place of labor and unto your pulpit, men and women will look upon you and say, 'Is that the same person? Oh, they are so different.' The anointing will lift you above the talents of your own individual flesh. It'll lift you into the realm of the Spirit. And so, the Lord will accomplish that which He has witnessed unto your own heart, and that vision that He gave you shall come again into clear perspective and with rejoicing, you shall see it come to pass. And your heart shall be glad, and your spirit shall rejoice and all those rounds about you shall be blessed. Yea, thou shalt be blessed. They people shall be blessed. They congregation shall be blessed. And all those rounds about thee shall be blessed and those that call you 'blessed' shall be blessed. For the blessing of the Lord Declaring rest upon you."
